Flu Vaccinations

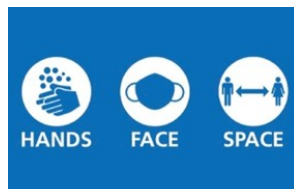
This year's flu vaccinations will be taking place on Monday 2nd November.
